

Gift Aid agreement

- ◆ You are appointing St Wilfrid's Hospice Retail Company Limited to act as your agent on your behalf in attempting to sell or dispose of the goods that you donate to us. Where goods are sold, a commission of 5% of the sale price plus VAT will be charged for this service and deducted from the proceeds of the sale.
- ◆ You own all of the goods that you bring to us for sale, you obtained them in a legal manner and you are not acting as a business. You agree that neither St Wilfrid's Hospice Retail Company Limited nor St Wilfrid's Hospice (Eastbourne) will be responsible for any loss or damage to any goods that you donate to us.
- ◆ You confirm that St Wilfrid's Hospice Retail Company Limited is instructed, as your agent, to donate the net proceeds of sale of your goods to St Wilfrid's Hospice and that it is not necessary to write to you to confirm the donations, provided that the total value of the net proceeds of sale of your goods so far in that tax year has not exceeded £1,000 (or such higher amount as specified by HM Revenue & Customs from time to time). Once a sale is made that brings the total value of the net proceeds of sale of your goods to more than £1,000 (or such higher amount as specified by HM Revenue & Customs from time to time), we must first write to you to confirm your consent to those funds over and above the initial £1,000 being donated. You will have 21 days from the date of notification to contact us for receipt of these funds less the commission specified above. You may notify us in writing at any time (at the address opposite), if you no longer want this arrangement to apply.
- ◆ An end of year letter, informing you of the value of all goods sold on your behalf in that tax year, will be sent to you before 31st May in the following tax year. This is a requirement of HM Revenue & Customs in order to confirm your status as a tax payer during the year and therefore our eligibility to claim the Gift Aid.
- ◆ You are a UK tax payer and you would like St Wilfrid's Hospice Retail Company Limited to make donations to St Wilfrid's (Eastbourne) on your behalf and you would like all donations that you make, or have made in the last four

years, to be treated as Gift Aid donations (until you notify us otherwise or this agreement is terminated). You understand that if you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations in the current tax year, it is your responsibility to pay any difference. In order to cover an initial donation of up to £1,000 without further notification from us, you must have paid at least £250 income tax or capital gains tax in the UK during this tax year before you sign up to this agreement.

- ◆ If we are unable to sell any of your goods after a period of 12 months from the date on which you donated them to us, St Wilfrid's Hospice Retail Company Limited is instructed, as your agent, to transfer ownership of those goods to St Wilfrid's Hospice (Eastbourne).
- ◆ You waive the right to claim interest that may have accrued on any cash you decide to reclaim from the sale of the items.
- ◆ Either you, or we, may terminate this agreement at any time by written notice.
- ◆ We may vary the terms of this agreement at any time by written notice to you.

We reclaim the tax from the Government, so there's no cost to you, or to us, and the money comes directly to St Wilfrid's. If you're a UK taxpayer, all we need you to do is fill in the form opposite and give it to us with your donations.
- 3 Signing up for Gift Aid is simple and will cost you nothing. However, it means we get 25% more, enabling us to offer more support to local people who have been diagnosed with terminal illness. Thank you so much for your support.
